The agenda included:
08-184r7 – More Idle Power Options

Gerry Houlder led the group through a review of 08-184 rev. 7. Areas specifically reviewed were the START STOP UNIT command and the new Inquiry VPD page, plus a couple of other comments. Changes requested include:

- a) adding bits to the new Inquiry VPD page indicating which of the power conditions are supported;
- b) multiple wording changes in table 61;
- c) changed warning about START STOP command might not result in the requested power condition; and
- d) rewording requirements for the START bit.

A revision including all of the suggested changes will be posted to T10 web site before the Dec. 10 telecon that is scheduled to continue critique of this proposal. That telecon will start by reviewing the new SPL model text and the model changes that were requested for the SPC and SBC model clauses.
